Community Giving Guidelines

Los Alamos National Bank (LANB) believes that giving back is an essential component of what makes us a community bank. **We provide monetary support, expertise and volunteers to organizations and causes that align with our strategic initiatives, support our values and provide benefits to improve the sustainability of the communities we serve.** When determining if a request for funding is the right fit, we measure it against our primary areas of giving. The bulk of this giving falls within the categories of youth, education, health and human services, economic development and animal welfare. If the funding request falls outside of these areas or does not benefit the communities of Los Alamos, White Rock, Santa Fe or Albuquerque, it will not qualify for funding from LANB.

Areas of Giving

Youth

We believe in investing in future leaders and promoting organizations that give a voice to our youth.

Education

We contribute to schools, classrooms and innovative outreach programs to help build thoughtful communities.

Health & Human Services

We support organizations that focus on social services and youth and family services.

Economic Development

We sponsor community events, projects and organizations that demonstrate the desire to create a positive impact on our local communities.

Animal Welfare

We support organizations that value animal life and advocate for their care and treatment.

Volunteer

Although not an area of giving, we do encourage our employees to serve in leadership roles and in positions within nonprofit organizations.

Things to know when applying

- Applications must be submitted at least 4 - 6 weeks prior to when your organization needs the contribution.
- A copy of your organization's W-9 or an IRS determination letter will be required to complete the application process.
- Please do not submit more than one request per organization per calendar year.
- We are less likely to make gifts for general operating expenses, make multi-year commitments and/or make gifts over \$10,000.
- We place the highest priority on applications that directly support our primary areas of giving.
- Funding is not guaranteed.

Funding Exclusions

- Religious organizations or affiliated activities
- Individual sponsorship for study, research, athletics or travel
- Capital requests
- Endowment funds
- Political candidates, organizations or campaigns
- Contributions to individuals or for profit organizations
